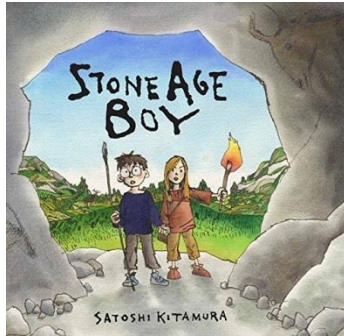

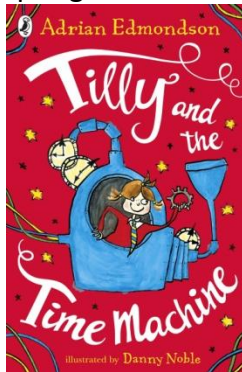


'Stone Age Boy' by Satoshi Kitamura

'Tilly and the Time Machine' by Adrian Edmondson

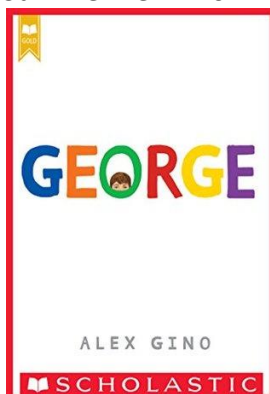
*Link to history: developing awareness of chronology*
