Research Pre-Historic Britain and create a mini-book to present the information that you find out.	Write an acrostic poem about the Stone Age. You can choose any word related to the topic to go down the side of the page.	Write a recipe using Stone Age ingredients. Have a go at making it and take a picture of your final dish.	Write a list of at least five questions which you would like to ask a Stone Age person.
Write your own Maths worded problems which use Stone Age as a topic. You could concentrate on addition, subtraction, multiplication or division or use a mixture of each.	Create a Stone Age timeline. When were the Palaeolithic, Mesolithic and Neolithic times? How many years does the Stone Age period cover?	Stone Age people seemed to have their own method of counting. Can you create your own method of counting? Will you count in sets of ten or do it another way?	Use some stones to design a way to explain hundreds, tens and units to another child.
How did people first settle in this country during the Stone Age? How did they travel and where did they come from? Present your information how you wish.	If you had been alive in the Stone Age, what animals would you have seen? Draw a picture of what it looks like before writing some information about it.	What did a Stone Age hill fort look like? Where have the remains of Stone Age hill forts been found in the United Kingdom? Mark them on a map. If you need one, ask Mrs Hales or Miss Quick.	What are flints? How were they made? What were they used for? Present your answers how you wish.
Paint a stone with an image of an animal	Design a piece of cave art using materials of your choice. i.e. mud, clay, grass, fruits and berries.	Make up your own story through cave art pictures to show a day in the life of a Stone Age family.	If you could give something from 2017 to the Stone Age people to improve their life, what would you give them? Draw a picture of three items and explain why you have chosen them.
Conduct some research into Stone Age houses. Create your own 3D model using natural materials.	Design and make an ancient stone circle or a replica of stonehenge.	Stone Age people could only colour their fabric using natural dyes. Try doing this yourself with natural resources like berries.	Make up your own quiz of facts about the Stone Age. Make sure you include the answers.
